All greyhounds must be presented bathed, free of fleas, nails trimmed and teeth cleaned. Greyhound must also be presented muzzled, collared and on a lead. Remember that the appearance is often of major importance to prospective adopters.

All greyhounds must enter the program with proof of current vaccination at minimum of C4 level.

All greyhounds entering the program must be free of significant health problems, kept up to date with vaccinations and be free of heartworm and have current appropriate preventative heartworm treatment.

No greyhounds will be taken into foster care unless the vaccinations are up to date (proof of vaccination must be provided prior to foster placement.) It is important that dogs have current vaccinations for their own health and safety and that of carer's pets. GAP has a responsibility to minimize risks for carers and the community.
